Pre-requisites:

1. No felony convictions. No firearms restrictions.
2. ***Get a LIVESCAN FINGERPRINTING Clearance Letter. Results can take up to 4 weeks and must be presented on first day of class in order to participate in course.**
3. Register for course with Stanislaus County Training Center
4. Pay fees to Stanislaus County Sheriff.

*** Students must present proof the pre-requisites were met ***

Course: The PC 832 Arrest Course is the minimum training standard for California peace officers as specified in the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Regulation 1005, and one of the first courses of instruction in the regular basic course modular training format.

The Arrest Course is a 40-hour requirement. This course consists of 13 topics, called Learning Domains. The Learning Domains contain the minimum required foundational information for given subjects. The training and testing specifications for a particular domain may also include information on required instructional activities and testing requirements.

The Arrest Course includes an 85-question, multiple-choice written examination and several skill examinations on Arrest and Control Techniques. The tests are graded pass/fail, with one re-test opportunity. If any re-test is failed, the course must be repeated in its entirety.

The first day of this course is mandatory. Students not completing the first session will not be admitted to the class. We reserve the right to cancel at any time due to low enrollment.
