PC 832 Firearms

Course Dates September 17-19, 2008

Pre-requisites:

1. No felony convictions.
2. No firearms restrictions. ***Get a LIVESCAN form at Stanislaus County Regional Training office***
3. Successful completion of livescan.
4. Complete admissions forms for San Joaquin Delta College and submit those forms to Delta's Admissions Office.
5. Accepted by San Joaquin Delta College as a student.
6. Register for course and pay unit fees to San Joaquin Delta College, all other fees payable to Stanislaus County Regional Training Division.

*** Students must present proof the pre-requisites were met ***

Course: The PC 832 Firearms Course is the minimum training standard for California peace officers as specified in the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Regulation 1005, and one of the first courses of instruction in the regular basic course modular training format.

The firearms course is a 24-hour requirement. This course consists of one topic, called a Learning Domain. The Learning domains contain the minimum required foundational information for given subjects. The training and testing specifications for a particular domain may also include information on required instructional activities and testing requirements.

The Firearms course includes a firearms range qualification examination. The test is graded pass/fail, with one re-test opportunity. If the re-test is failed, the course must be repeated in its entirety.

More information regarding the course and students' expectations will be provided during the orientation program presented during the first class session. The first session of this course is mandatory. Students not completing the first session will not be admitted to the class.

Cost: The costs for the program depend upon state law, vendor, and third-party provider fees. The costs provided are estimates and subject to change without notice:
