PC 832 Firearms

Pre-requisites:

1. No felony convictions. No firearm restrictions.
2. ***Get a LIVESCAN FINGERPRINTING Clearance Letter. Results can take up to 4 weeks and must be presented on first day of class in order to participate in course.**
3. Register for course with Stanislaus County Training Center
4. Pay fees to Stanislaus County Sheriff.

*** Students must present proof the pre-requisites were met ***

Course: The PC 832 Firearms Course is the minimum training standard for California peace officers as specified in the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Regulation 1005, and one of the first courses of instruction in the regular basic course modular training format.

The firearms course is a 24-hour requirement. This course consists of one topic, called a Learning Domain. The Learning domains contain the minimum required foundational information for given subjects. The training and testing specifications for a particular domain may also include information on required instructional activities and testing requirements.

The Firearms course includes a firearms range qualification examination. The test is graded pass/fail, with one re-test opportunity. If the re-test is failed, the course must be repeated in its entirety.

The first day of this course is mandatory. Students not completing the first session will not be admitted to the class. We reserve the right to cancel the course at any time due to low enrollment.

This course meets the requirements of PC 12050 for application of carry concealed weapons permit (CCW).

Equipment Needed:

All Firearms, subject to inspection by Range Master.

- *Firearm; Semi-Automatic 9, 40 or 45 caliber only
- *3 Magazines
- *500 rounds of Ammunition
- *Eyes and Ear protection
- *Long Pants / Shirt with Sleeves / Hat / Full Covered Shoes.
- *Holster and Magazine Pouch

Required: Livescan Fingerprinting, need to have letter of clearance on first day of class
