S.T.O.P. (Sheriff's Tactical Operations Program) is designed to be completed over a 4/10 (40 hour) training week and specifically geared toward completing ALL mandated Perishable Skills, Continued Professional Training, and State Mandated training. The course schedule is as follows:

Defensive Tactics / Racial Profiling / Range

Students will be actively involved utilizing a broad base of instruction from instructors from throughout the region.
