Regular Basic Academy

Pre-requisites:

1. No felony convictions.
2. No firearms restrictions. (obtain a livescan form from the training center \$70)
3. Valid driver's license (class C or higher).
4. Completed the admissions forms for SJDC and submit them to SJDC's Admissions Office (free).
5. Accepted by SJDC as a student.
6. Pay unit fees to San Joaquin Delta College, all other fees payable to Stanislaus County Regional Training Division.

Course:

This course satisfies the POST (Peace Officer Standards and Training) requirements for Police Officer. The Regular Basic course is the entry-level training requirement for all California peace officers, as specified in POST, Regulation 1005. The Regular Basic Course prepares each student by providing hands-on experience, including weapons training, role-play scenarios, patrol procedures, emergency vehicle operations (EVOC), and arrest and control techniques. The student must pass written, scenario, and physical abilities tests, to demonstrate readiness for entry into a department's standardized Field Training program. Specific minimum training and testing requirements for the Regular Basic Course can be found in Commission Procedure D-1. Students successfully completing the course will have met the requirements for a Certificate of Completion of the Regular Basic Academy.

The course is 930 hours long and runs for 24 weeks. Monday-Thursday 0700-1800. Discipline, physical fitness, the acquiring of knowledge to perform the duties of a peace officer, skills development, demonstration of abilities and professional conduct are stressed throughout the course. Information regarding the course, pre-requisites and students' expectations will be provided during the mandatory orientation held prior to the first day of class. The below listed fees are approximate and may change without notice.

3. **Ammunition** ****DO NOT PURCHASE YOUR OWN AMMUNITION**** **\$1200.00**
Students not sponsored by an agency must use academy provided weapons & ammunition.
Included in Fees are:
 - 3000 rounds of handgun ammo
 - 200 rounds of shotgun ammo (12 gauge, 2 ¾ inch, 00 buck shot)
 - 75 rounds of shotgun ammo (12 gauge, slugs)

4. **Materials Fee** **\$350.00**
The Training Center provides the following for the recruit:
 - Range Targets
 - Eye/Ear Protection
 - Air-Soft Pistol
 - Air-Soft Gas Cartridges
 - Academy Patches

5. **Uniforms**
Students must provide their own uniforms for the Academy. A representative from the uniform company will be present at the orientation. The attached list details the required and recommended uniform items and is provided strictly for the courtesy of Academy students. A letter of "acceptance" into the Academy must be presented to the uniform vendor before purchase of the items.

6. **Additional required items**
All students are responsible for providing the following items:
 - One (1) pair department authorized black shoes that take a high shine (no patent leather).
 - Flashlight (RTO approved).
 - Combination lock for gym locker.
 - Good running shoes.

7. **Workbooks**
Student workbooks may be purchased through the Kinko's Website. Cost for having the workbooks printed is approximately \$400.00
